

# **Golf Course Etiquette Made Simple**

### Who goes first:

- Furthest away hits first
- Ready Golf speeds play player who is ready first hits first
- Wrong Fairway player on correct fairway hits first
- > Honors (For Information Only) player who had the best score on prior hole hits first

#### Where to Stand:

- $\blacktriangleright$  On tee to right and slightly behind tee
- > On green: Out of line of sight (including peripheral vision)
- > Never directly behind a player

#### On the Green:

- Player on green whose ball is closest to pin pulls pin (flagstick)
- Place on ground away from line of putt of all players gently
- Player who holes out first replaces the flag
- > Never walk in someone else's line on the green
- > Tend flag from the low side keep your shadow away from the hole

## Taking care of the course:

- ➢ Fix your ball marks
- Replace Divots (or seed hole)
- Don't throw the flagstick
- Rake bunkers \*\* enter on low side \*\* Smooth with foot -

Push the sand away with bottom of rake - pull sand back toward you with rake tines

# Pace of Play:

- Keep up with the group in front of you
- No more than: One practice swing (only if it helps)
  - 30 seconds to hit (less if scoring over 90 for 18 holes)
  - 1 minute to look for ball (Rules of Golf give you 5 minutes)
- Check markers for distance on way to ball
- Track other player's balls
- Call group behind you up on par 3's

## General:

- > Don't touch another player's ball without permission
- Never give or ask for advice penalty (Distance is not advice)
- Mulligans don't exist & Whiffs count!
- Quiet and still on the golf course NO cell phones!

# **Dress Code:**

- No short shorts or mini-skirts (Shorts just above knee)
- Collared Shirts required (No back-less halter shirts)
- ➢ No jeans ever!

# **Golf Carts:**

- Place all carts towards tee-box for next hole
- Motorized Keep at least 30 feet away from green

Don't drive on steep hills, on mounds or near bunkers

Pull Carts - Never bring onto green or tee-box
