EWGA MEMBERSHIP: INQUIRING MINDS WANT TO KNOW!

- **Can I join more than one Chapter?** Yes - Many members decide to join more than one Chapter – either because they spend time in more than one location during the year or perhaps because they want to participate in events in more than one Chapter to maximize their membership (*especially when the Chapters are in close proximity.*)
- **How do I join another Chapter?** To join a secondary Chapter, contact the EWGA HQ office at 800-407-1477, x10. Ask that the second Chapter be added to your profile, and pay the \$35 fee for the dual membership. As a standard practice, EWGA Chapter members are always encouraged to participate in activities hosted by other Chapters. However, if you want to participate in activities more than 2-3 times during any given season with that other Chapter, you need to join that second Chapter.
- **My membership has lapsed. How do I renew?** The NEW member application is for those who are joining the first time. If someone has lapsed or was a former member, even if it was several years ago, members only need to pay the renewal fee, and use the RENEWAL form.
 - Current members should renew online rather than submitting a form in the mail or by fax. Personalized renewal forms will be mailed to all members soon.
 - **To renew** : go to : www.myewga.com, then login to go to the 'Members Only' Area. The third button on the left after login is "Membership Renewal". Click on "Membership Renewal". Then click on "Pay Open Orders", and enter your credit card details. Hit 'Submit', and the process is complete.

- **I recently joined or renewed my membership, but can't seem to register for an event.** If you are a new member or you've just renewed a lapsed membership, you may not yet be listed in the member database for chapter on-line event registration. Please reach out to the Event Captain for the event you are trying to register for and they can help you.
- **I'm trying to log on to the National website with my user name and password but it isn't working.** There are different log ins for the local Chapter and for National. You have *one for National and one for chapter on-line registration*. The email address you chose for National will be the same for the chapter registration BUT your chapter password is your EWGA member's number and NOT your password for National.

2013 Women's Golf League Information

FEES

- **League Administration Fee - \$60** This non-refundable, annual fee is required to join one or more leagues.
- **Security Deposit - \$50** This deposit is required to join one or more leagues. The Security Deposit is paid one time and rolls over year to year. It will be refunded in total upon resignation from league play and upon written request, provided all greens fees are up-to-date. To the extent that any interest is earned on the security deposit, it shall be regarded as additional service cost payable to the Chapter, and members will not be entitled to payment of such interest.
- **Greens Fees** Pay as you play. The greens fees are payable directly to the golf course each week. The offerings and fees noted below were correct at the time of printing and are subject to change. Members are also responsible for greens fees if they are late in cancelling a tee time request or fail to show up for a requested tee time.

The Travel League plays at various courses across Suffolk County, including Cherry Creek, Pine Hills, Spring Lake, Swan Lake and many others.

Many of the 9 hole leagues allow members may play up to 18 holes, daylight permitting, at the discretion of the starter. Additional play is not available at the Harbor Links Executive, Heartland, Cherry Creek, Peninsula, Spring Lake, or Match Play leagues.

League play begins April 30th and continues through mid-September. The Travel League plays through late October. Match Play leagues convene on alternating weeks and distribute their own schedules.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Leagues are provided for all skill levels. When selecting a league, please note that league membership is contingent upon compliance with all rules and procedures described in the "2013 League Handbook." Infractions against policy, etiquette, or required pace of play may be grounds for the league committee, at its discretion, to require reassignment to a different league or cancellation of league membership. The League Handbook and other important information will be attached to your League Welcome E-Mail. 2013 Women's Golf League Information (cont.)

Leagues: are exclusive to EWGA-LI members in good standing with National membership dues paid in full.

Applications: Starting this year, members will register for leagues online on the Chapter website, www.ewgali.org, where payment may be made by credit card. New EWGA-LI league members will pay a total of \$110, and returning members will pay a total of \$60. To complete the online registration, applicants must also agree to the terms of the Release and Indemnification Agreement.

Membership: Members will receive a Welcome email from each league they join. The Welcome email provides league-specific procedures for requesting tee times, cancelling requests, checking in, submitting scorecards, etc.

Home League: Members must select a Home League when applying for league membership. The Home League is where the member plans to play the most. Members are automatically eligible to participate in the League Championship for the Home League.

Multiple League Play: Members may join one or more additional leagues. To participate in the League Championship for the additional leagues, the member must have played a minimum of five weeks excluding the Championship rounds. EXCEPTION: Only Home League members may participate in the League Championship at Harbor Links Exec., Heartland, and Cantiague.

Weekly Tournaments: Members are automatically eligible to participate in any weekly tournaments at their Home League and may participate in weekly tournaments of any additional leagues, except beginner leagues. Only Home League members of beginner leagues are eligible to play in those tournaments. Only 1 trophy may be awarded to an individual per league. A member who wins a League Championship trophy is not eligible to win an individual weekly tournament. All members may participate in any team tournaments.

Mandatory Handicaps: Handicaps must be maintained at all non-beginner leagues. Members are responsible for entering all scores into an approved handicap system. Access to the NGN system is included in your EWGA National membership. Access to EWGA GHIN is also available for modest fee. If a system other than NGN is used, the member must notify each league's scoring captain of the system in use and the member's account number. Failure to maintain a handicap or notify the league where the handicap is maintained renders the member ineligible to receive any tournament awards.

End of Season Awards Dinner: All league members are invited to attend the End of Season Celebration on October 1, 2013 when tournament awards will be presented, many individual accomplishments will be acknowledged, and the entire season will be remembered and celebrated.

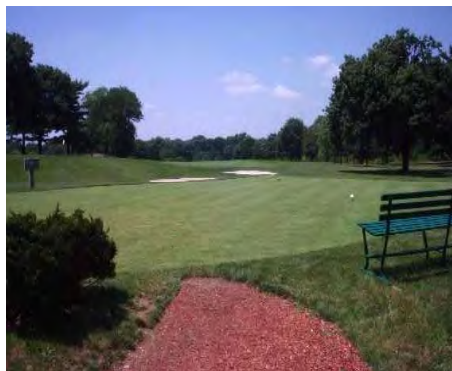

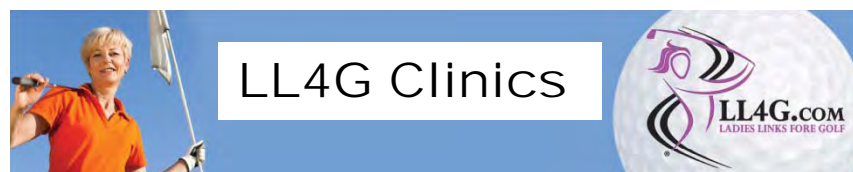

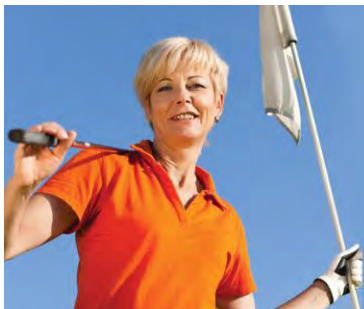
