



Code of Conduct

LPGA Amateur Golf Association members share the responsibility of demonstrating exemplary conduct, sportsmanship, respect, and courtesy at all times when participating in LPGA Amateur events and conducting LPGA Amateurs business. Behavior Contrary to this is unacceptable and will not be tolerated. LPGA Amateur Golf Association members are reminded that they represent the LPGA, including LPGA Tour Players, LPGA Professionals, Girls Golf, and their follow LPGA Amateurs 'members.

Examples of a breach in the Code of Conduct by an LPGA Amateurs member that may result in consequences include (but are not limited to) the following:

- Use of Profanity, either in frustration or directed toward another individual
- Inappropriate, derogatory, disrespectful, or abusive language/gestures directed toward other players, the host club, host club staff member, or an LPGA Amateur Golf Association Staff or volunteer
- Disruptive of distracting behavior
- Throwing of equipment or other items
- Intentionally causing damage to the golf course or objects on course property or facility
- Use of cell phone/electronic device for purposes other than those permitted by the Rules
- Other unbecoming or inappropriate conduct as determined by the LPGA Amateur Golf Association.

Consequences for a breach in the code of conduct are based on the past history of the member's conduct and the severity of the situation
